RE: THE ALARMING SITUATION REGARDING WATER SUPPLY

The Board met on July 19, 1986 to discuss our diminishing water supply. It is imperative to bring the present condition to the attention of each Romaldo Water Company user. Water conservation is of the utmost importance, especially at this critical time.

- * It has been discovered that the ground water table has gone down. The available well capacity has dropped 8 feet. This condition warrants the immediate attention of all water users.
- * The electric bill for pumping water has doubled, showing that twice as much water is being pumped. Not only is an excess of water being used, there is extra strain on the equipment.
- Watch for leaks, especially leaking toilets, broken water lines, faucets which have been left on, and daily household use.
- * With extra caution in using only a minimum amount of water, we may be able to stop further lowering of the water table and get by during this crucial period and the fire season.
