This is in response to your request for a “Will Serve” letter from Romaldo Community Water Company for 5591 West Camino Cielo. Romaldo will serve 5591 as long as your water demand does not grow more than 10X its current demand of 200 gallons/ day. In other words, if 5591’s usage does not exceed 2,000 gallons/ day, any increased is within Romaldo’s capacity to serve.

Romaldo is a “State small domestic water system”. For the last decade total usage has been 1,500 to 3,000 gallons/ day. At its maximum, total demand is 2.1 gallons per minute (gpm).

Romaldo’s new well, as tested by Cascade Well & Pump at 54 gpm¹ for 24 hours on 28-29 June 2017, demonstrated the well becomes inefficient when pumped at rates greater than 40 gpm and that the pumping rate recommended to secure maximum efficiency is 20 gpm. This means the total well capacity is 29,000 gallons/ day, or 10X the current total consumption.

¹ Based on a step drawdown test to determine the appropriate pumping rate to be used for the drawdown, the well was pumped for an hour at successive rates of 20, 30, 40, 50, and 58 gpm.
