The most recent Health Department report on our well came out unsatisfactory and more stringent measures will be taken to insure that our future water quality is satisfactory. We took the standard measures to chlorinate the well and storage tanks in early May and again in early June. Since simple chlorination did not solve the problem, we will completely drain the storage tank and clean it out on Wednesday, June 29. To avoid a major loss of water, the well pump has been turned off and we will be using up the water in the storage tank. Water will be shut off from Wednesday morning around 8 a.m. and will remain off until Wednesday night or Thursday morning. Those of us without storage tanks will be without water during that period of time so please prepare yourselves. After the water comes back on, any water that has a strong chlorine smell should be run to waste. Do not drink the water until all smell of chlorine has gone away.

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
